Governor Dunc Mills played an introductory note on the Xylophone and President Jack Bowen welcomed 21 Gyros to the December 19<sup>th</sup> luncheon meeting held at the Derrick Golf and Winter Club.

**President Jack** presented a summary of the discussion held at the November 29<sup>th</sup> Board Meeting.

- Our focus will be on the recruitment of new members in the age 55 plus category.
- A survey will be sent out to all Members to solicit their views on new member recruitment.
- The 2024 Meeting Calendar will reflect a revised approach to Club meetings. There will be three broad categories: Guest Speakers, Life Story presentations by Club Members and outside/outdoor, activities.
- We need to designate a Club Member who will report on the health of Club Members.

Governor Dunc reviewed our meeting arrangements for January and February 2024 at the Mill Woods Golf Course, Woodvale Clubhouse.

A three salads, soup and sandwich option will cost \$21 including tip and tax. We likely will charge \$25 to cover free lunches and guests.

A hot lunch buffet with two choices of entrees will cost \$27-30 including tip and tax.

A plated dinner for our Valentines mixed event with 8 menu selections would cost \$47.

There are no room rental fees if we book more than four meetings. We will be charged for the exact number of Members committed to attend. A projector for audio-visual presentations is not available.

After our Valentines Party Event on February 14<sup>th</sup>, we will need to review our luncheon meeting requirements for the remainder of 2024 at either the Derrick Club or Woodvale/Millwoods.

Governor Dunc then reviewed the details for the 2024 District VIII Convention. Since no Gyro Club has volunteered to host the 2024 Convention, the District VIII Executive Committee has made the decision to hold a two-day Convention in Lacombe, Alberta on Wednesday, June 19<sup>th</sup>, and Thursday June 20<sup>th</sup>. Golf would be played on Wednesday morning, registration would begin at 3:00pm, followed by hospitality and a Dine Around Dinner. Bocce and horseshoe tournaments could also be held. A Gyro Summer Celebration would be held on the first day of summer, June 20<sup>th</sup>.

**Fred Schulte** reviewed the Meeting Schedules for January to June and July to December 2024.

In accordance with the direction by the Executive and Board of Directors, **Outdoor Activities** will be scheduled for April, May, June, July, and September. Luncheon meetings will be held with a minimum of one per month in the Spring and Summer. These meetings will include guest speakers and presentations by Club Members.
