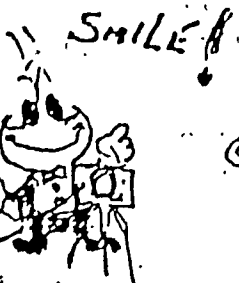
We look forward to our usual good attendance so come out and bring a guest.
