Induction of new members: **Marty Larson** presented a brief history of Gyro to **Leon Lubin**, **Ari (Dutch) Hoeksema** and **Sam Gruden** and formally inducted the three into the Club. **Walter Yakimets**, **Bryce Van Dusen** and **Mike Matei** as sponsors respectively pinned the new members. Each of the new members was greeted by the members present.

New member biographies were presented by Ron Ramsey and Bill Taylor.

Ron Ramsey stated that he was born in Carlyle, Saskatchewan and at an early stage decided that he wanted to be Pharmacist like his father or a medical doctor. He opted for medicine and attended the University of Saskatchewan in Saskatoon, graduating in 1959 with an internship following in Calgary. During 1960-62, Ron worked in residency at the old Royal Alex hospital in Edmonton. Significant changes were occurring in the delivery of medicine in Saskatchewan at this time and Ron chose to set up his first medical practice in Edmonton. Ron with a partner set up one of the first medical clinics in the Laurier Heights area as general practitioners. Ron developed a lot of close relationships with his patients over the years, continuing until 1997. He then moved to the Allin Clinic until 2003 and then worked part time until his retirement on 2005. Ron married Marlene in 1960 and they raised two boys and a girl who also chose medicine as their careers. Ron and Marlene are proud grandparents of two. Ron's many hobbies and interests include curling, skiing, hiking and baroque music.

Bill Taylor advised that his parents moved to Montreal in 1939 and he was born in December 1943. At this same time, the recording industry introduced cellophane tape. He is a graduate of Montreal High School and Sir George Williams University. In 1971, Bill left Montreal and toured Europe, returning to look for work in Montreal, Toronto and London. He started with Westinghouse in Winnipeg and was moved subsequently to Edmonton and then Calgary. In 1986, Bill returned to Edmonton with Marie and has been in the same house for 20 years. His work for over 30 years has been in sales and marketing of electrical products. For the last 15 years Bill has operated his own rep agency, Technalines which has brought many small manufacturers to the marketplace. Bill's interests include many types of music including singing in local choirs as well as photography and wood working. Physical fitness has also been a priority commitment over the last 38 years. Bill is a prostate cancer survivor and an expert on all types of treatment. Bill's association with the Canadian Cancer Society in the public education area brought him into our Gyro club through his participation in the Drive for the Cure Prostate Cancer Golf Tourney.
