EXECUTIVE AND DIRECTORS' MEETING

At an Executive and Directors' Meeting held at the home of President Mortimer on Wednesday, February 5, 1986 the resignations of Orest Filewych and Elmer MacGillivray were received. Because of business commitments they were unable to attend the luncheons meetings. It was moved by Dick Ogilvie and seconded by Allan Warrack that the two resignations be accepted with regret.

Carried.

A motion by Allan Warrack and Ron Holmes recommended that the Edmonton Gyro Club act as host for the International Gyro Convention and the District VIII Convention for 1996. This is also the year of the 75 th Anniversary of the founding of the Edmonton Gyro Club.

2nd Lieutenant Governor Marty Larson will bring this matter to the attention of the International Gyro Interim Meeting at San Diego, California on February 12 through 16, 1986.

Allan Warrack presented a plan for the financing of the 1996 conventions by investing the existing Convention Fund and the proceeds from the Hockey Pool from now to 1996 at 10% compounded annually; a transfer of \$10000.00 from the Park Fund invested at 10% compounded annually; and possible new fund

raising efforts such as bottle drives, raffles, draws, auctions etc. the proceeds from which to be invested at 10% compounded annually. The projected future value of these investments would be approximately \$100000.00, which would basically carry the conventions.

Dick Ogilvie agreed to bring in Terms of Reference for the Benevolence Fund. The meeting adjourned at 10.20 p.m.
